Registration and packet pick-up will be from 7:00 PM - 9:00 PM at the Embassy Suites, 1000 Woodward Place NE, Albuquerque, NM 87102. (505) 245-7100.

Thursday, June 3rd

Registration and packet pick-up will be from 7:00 - 9:00 AM & 5:00 - 9:00 PM at the Embassy Suites. Multiple rides will start at the Embassy Suites parking lot at 8:00 AM. There will be a welcome reception at the Embassy Suites at 7:00 PM.

Friday, June 4th

Registration and packet pick-up will be from 7:00 - 9:00 AM & 4:00 - 6:00 PM at the Embassy Suites. Multiple rides including lunch will start at the Embassy Suites parking lot at 8:00 AM including a ride to Belen returning by the Rail Runner train (limited to 40 riders). A ride to Nob Hill to see the movie *Route 66 by Bicycle* will start at 5:00 PM.

Saturday, June 5th

The Albuquerque Century/Tour de Cure (with 10, 25, 50, and 65 mile options) will start at the Embassy Suites parking lot at 6:30 AM. The Rally Banquet with entertainment and a guest speaker will be at the Embassy Suites at 6:00 PM.

Sunday, June 6th

An easy ride along the scenic Bosque Trail will start at the Embassy Suites parking lot at 8:00 AM. A challenging climb up to the Sandia Crest (10,640 ft.) will start east of town at 8:00 AM. A ride to Old Town to see a western gun fight will start at Noon.

Sag Support and Safety

Sag support will be provided on the Saturday Century. All riders must wear ANSI, Snell or ASTM certified bicycle helmets and obey traffic laws. Please choose routes within your capabilities and be prepared to make minor repairs. We cannot anticipate every road surface hazard or construction project you will encounter on this rally. Use common sense and caution at all times.

About the Rally

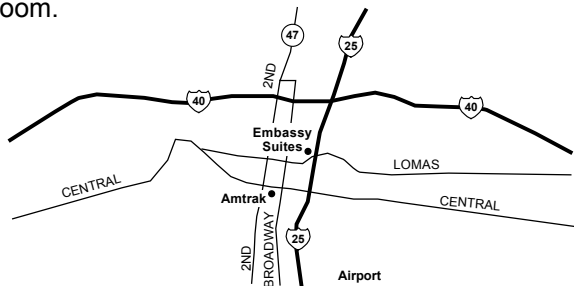
The League of American Bicyclists, founded in 1880 as the League of American Wheelmen, has hosted National Rallies for many years. 2010 marks 130 years since the League's first National Rally was held in Newport, Rhode Island. The National Rally will be held in New Mexico for the first time, and is being presented by the League of American Bicyclists, the Bicycle Coalition of New Mexico, New Mexico Touring Society, the American Diabetes Association, BikeABQ, the City of Albuquerque and The Kickstand.

The 2010 Rally will also be the first Annual State of New Mexico Bicycle Rally, which will be continued in future years by the Bicycle Coalition of New Mexico. The Bicycle Coalition of New Mexico was founded in 2001 by Gail Ryba to help protect cyclists rights at the State level.

Getting There

Albuquerque is located at the intersection of I-25 and I-40. The Albuquerque International Airport is serviced by ten commercial airlines. Albuquerque is also a major stop for both Amtrak and Greyhound.

The Embassy Suites, headquarters for the 2010 Rally, is located in downtown Albuquerque near the I-25/I-40 interchange, three miles north of the Airport and less than a mile from the Amtrak and Greyhound Stations. Embassy Suites has special Rally rates available for \$109 per night. Be sure to ask for the Bicycle Rally rate when booking your room.

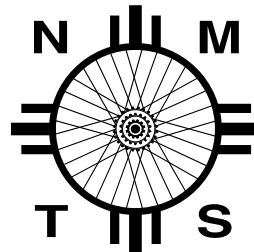
